Some are also grown on their own roots as cuttings which many gardeners are happy to plant and be a little patient whilst they develop. The code O.F. (Old Fashioned) or Modern is to help you with the prices of our roses.

## ALISTER CLARK

- DAYDREAM 1925** \$14  
A large shrub or climber with large, almost single soft pink blooms. Recurrent.
- EDITOR STEWART 1939** \$14  
A large shrub or climber young bronze foliage with large open almost single deep cherry-red flowers. Recurrent.
- GLADSOME - CUTTING** \$9  
A very pretty Spring-flowering rambler with large clusters of single bright rose-pink blooms with paler centres and yellow stamens.Looks pretty near "Edna Walling" or "Blush Rambler".To about 4m.Cuttings only.
- GWEN NASH 1920** \$14  
A large shrub or climber with glaucous foliage and large almost single rich pink blooms with white centres.Slightly fragrant and recurrent.To about 2.5m.O.F
- LADY HUNTINGFIELD 1937** \$14  
A pretty rose with shining foliage and fully double ochre-yellow blooms on strong stems.Recurrent.To about 1.2m.
- LORRAINE LEE 1924** \$14  
An evergreen shrub with double cupped rosy apricot-pink blooms all season.Foliage is rich green and a lovely foil for the blooms.If in a frosty area prune during Summer.
- MARGARET TURNBULL** \$14  
This climber bears soft pink blooms on amber ground. Recurrent. This does not always perform well. It can sulk during Spring but is quite superb in Autumn.O.F.2.5m
- MARJORY PALMER 1936** \$14  
A bushy compact shrub with glossy dark foliage and clusters of fragrant bright pink blooms all season.Easy to grow.
- MRS HAROLD BROOKES 1931** \$15  
(Hybrid Tea 1931) Red, fragrant,double cupped flowers. Light coloured foliage and bushy growth. 1.4m.
- MRS.FRED DANKS 1951** \$14  
A large bush or pillar rose with semi-double very fragrant blooms of pink with a lilac tint.Beautiful in the bud and makes a nice cut flower.Recurrent.To about 1.8m.
- QUEEN OF HEARTS** \$15  
This robust strong growing variety leaves a nostalgic impression of colour and bud shape. Large cup shape blooms in a cherry red and apricot are produced on long single stems with glossy foliage. 1.5m PBR
- RESTLESS** \$14  
A good strong almost thornless shrub bearing medium sized semi-double dark red blooms. Fully recurrent.
- SCORCHER 1922** \$14  
In the style of New Dawn, this rambling-type climbing rose bears clusters of semi-double brilliant scarlet-crimson blooms mainly in Spring with some later flowering.
- SQUATTERS DREAM** \$14  
A very showy rose with dark bronze-green foliage and small open almost single saffron to Indian-yellow blooms all season.Likes a sunny position.To about 1.5m.
- SUITOR 1942** \$16  
A dwarf spreading shrub with clusters of small double bright pink blooms all season.Glossy foliage.O.F.budded & cuttings
- SUNLIT 1937** \$16  
This is a wonderful rose which never fails to please.The medium-sized peachy-apricot blooms are globular in shape and are produced in astounding numbers all season.They are held in small clusters on thornless stems.1m.

## DAVID AUSTIN

- A SHROPSHIRE LAD** 1996 **\$14**  
 Related to "Leander" from which it inherits vigorous healthy and near thornless growth this small climber bears soft peachy-pink blooms of a slightly cupped rosette formation. To about 2m. PBR.
- ABRAHAM DARBY** 1985 **\$14**  
 This is a very beautiful shrub of nice shape with large deeply cupped blooms in shades of pink and yellow and in spite of their size they continue to be produced all season. The fragrance is rich and fruity with refreshing sharpness.
- ALNWICK CASTLE** 2005 **\$14**  
 Pretty rich pink cup-shaped buds gradually open to a deeply cupped flower later developing into a broadfull-petalled shallow cup of soft pink which is paler at the outer edges. Nice rounded bushy growth. PBR. Budded only.
- AMBRIDGE ROSE** 1990 **\$14**  
 A short bushy plant well suited to bedding purposes. The blooms are apricot-pink becoming very soft pale pink towards the edges. Very free-flowering and trouble free. Myrrh fragrance. Grows to about 1m. or a little more. PBR budded only.
- ANNE BOLEYN** 2002 **\$14**  
 An exceptionally free-flowering variety with quite short arching growth. The flowers are of nice rosette shape and are soft warm pink. They are produced in quite large sprays and it has soft green highly-polished foliage. Very recurrent. 1.25m.
- BELLE STORY** 1984 **\$14**  
 The attraction of this rose is the beautiful and unusual formation of the flowers which are wide open and incurved with a pronounced boss of amber stamens rather like a paeony. They are large and soft pink in colour and produced in profusion. 1.2m
- BENJAMIN BRITTEN** 2003 **\$14**  
 The blooms of this variety are an unusual mix of orange and red. The deeply cupped blooms gradually develop into a slightly cupped rosette. The shrub is of medium height and vigorous dense growth and excellent foliage. Fruity fragrance. Repeats well. 1.2m.
- BROTHER CADFAEL** 1990 **\$14**  
 Giant globular clear pink blooms almost paeony-like. These are held on a substantial shrub with flowers, foliage and growth all in proportion. Later blooms may be a little smaller. Fragrance very strong. 1.5m.
- CANTERBURY** 1969 **\$14**  
 Very large, pure pink, almost single flowers open wide with slightly wavy, almost translucent petals and prominent golden stamens. Fragrant. 75cm.
- CHARLES AUSTIN** **\$14**  
 Large blooms in shades of yellow and deep apricot. Tall healthy growth blooms have a fruity fragrance. 2m
- CHARLES DARWIN** 2005 **\$14**  
 The blooms are full and deeply cupped at first then opening to a shallower flower usually revealing a button-eye. The colour can be described as yellow tending to mustard. There is a strong delicious fragrance. A wide and spreading shrub to about 1.4m. PBR
- CHARLES RENNIE MACKINTOSH** **\$14**  
 Flowers are a distinctly lilac shade of pink with a powerful fragrance produced on a tough thorny bushy plant. 1.2m.
- CHARLOTTE** 1999 **\$16**  
 Exquisite cup-shaped flowers of medium-size and soft yellow in colour. The growth is compact bushy and rather upright. One of the most beautiful of the yellow Austins. Very hardy as well. Tea Rose fragrance. To about 1m. PBR
- CHAUCER** 1970 **\$14**  
 A rather upright shrub with quite large deeply cupped chalice-shaped blooms. They are strongly myrrh-scented. Can be a bit prone to downy mildew. Will reach about 1.2m. Budded only.
- CHRISTOPHER MARLOWE** 2004 **\$14**  
 The flowers are rosette-shaped intense orange-red paling a little to salmon-pink on the outer petals as the flower ages. Short vigorous growth which results in a free-flowering shrub to about 1m. PBR
- CLAIRE ROSE** 1986 **\$14**  
 Large blooms of delicate blush-pink reminiscent of "Souvenir de la Malmaison". Strong upright growth with light-green foliage. Fragrant and recurrent. To about 1.3m. Budded only.
- COMTES DE CHAMPAGNE** 2004 **\$16**  
 A beautiful cupped bloom of yellow with buff hints which age to soft yellow much the same shade as the flowers of "Wildflower". There are deep yellow stamens showing and a scent of honey and musk. The shrub grows wide, low and bushy to about 1m. PBR

- CONSTANCE SPRY 1961** *Shade tolerant* **\$14**  
This was David Austin's first introduction. It is still a great favourite with large double rich rose-pink blooms in Spring. Fragrant. A large cascading climber or rambling shrub to about 4m. Needs some support.
- COTTAGE ROSE** **\$14**  
A good rose which blooms all season and is trouble-free and pretty. It has charming, medium-sized cupped blooms in lovely warm pink. It repeats blooms very quickly. Light fragrance. O.F.
- CROCUS ROSE 2002** **\$14**  
This is a very robust and free-flowering rose bearing large rosette-shaped flowers that are cupped at first and later reflexing. The colour is soft apricot paling to cream on the outer petals and finally aging to soft cream all over.
- CROWN PRINCESS MARGARETA 2002** **\$14**  
A tall slightly arching shrub which is ideal for the back of the garden or as a small climber. The flowers are quite large neatly formed rosettes of lovely apricot-orange. It is one of the "Leander" group with strong fruity fragrance. 1.75m.
- CYMBELINE 1982** **\$14**  
Large pale grey to pink flowers with white edging and hints of buff at centre of bloom. These come in clusters, the foliage is healthy and dark green with reddish new growth. Can grow to 2m in hot climate.
- DARCY BUSSELL 2008** **\$16**  
A short shrubby rose perfect for a bed or border or planted in a large container. Blooms are a deep Mauve or Crimson rosette in form and have a fruity fragrance. 80cm
- DOVE 1984** **\$14**  
Large flowers are white with a hint of mother of pearl at the centre, in clusters of 7. Better in dry climates, lovely dark green leaves on a short plant. 75cm
- EGLANTYNE 1997** **\$16**  
One of the most beautiful English Roses. The blooms are perfectly formed the petals turning up at the edges to form an almost saucer-shape. Colour is pale pink and blooms are very fragrant. Medium bushy twiggy growth with nice foliage and good health. 1.5m
- ELLEN 1984** **\$14**  
Double flowers of Apricot with a deeper centre. Strong shrub and fragrant. 1.3m
- EVELYN 1997** **\$15**  
Very large blooms of perfect shallow saucer-like formation with numerous petals which recurve to form a rosette shape. They are apricot and pink and are wonderfully fragrant. Strong bushy upright growth to about 1.8m. PBR
- FAIR BIANCA 1982** **\$14**  
A pure white fully double flat and quartered bloom which is similar to "Mme. Hardy" or "Botzaris". The bush is small and upright to about 90cm. The flowers are sweetly scented. A nice little rose for small gardens. Budded only.
- FALSTAFF 2002** **\$14**  
A very striking rose with large blooms of the richest dark crimson fading to purple with age. Grows into an excellent climber with flowers all the way up the stems. Strong fragrance of Old Rose. To 1.8m. PBR
- FISHERMANS FRIEND 1987** **\$14**  
Quite large full-petalled flowers cupped at first later forming an attractive rosette. The colour is deep garnet-red to deep cerise-crimson as the flower ages. Strong thorny growth and strong fragrance. To about 1.2m.
- GERTRUDE JEKYLL 1986** **\$14**  
A strong-growing shrub with magnificent large rosettes of rich pink opening from perfectly scrolled little buds. Wonderfully fragrant. To about 2m. PBR
- GLAMIS CASTLE 1992** **\$16**  
A short prickly shrub with clusters of fragrant cupped double blooms of creamy-buff to white. The foliage is dark and abundant and the shrub is very generous with blooms. To about 80cm. PBR.
- GOLDEN CELEBRATION** **\$14**  
A nicely rounded shrub with clusters of very double cupped blooms of deep golden-yellow with strong fragrance. Nice dark foliage. Grows to about 1.5m. PBR.
- GRACE 2003** **\$14**  
An excellent variety with flowers of lovely pure apricot. The colour intensifies towards the middle of the flower. The flower is shallowly cupped at first and slowly opens to form a rosette with the outer petals reflexing. 1.6m.

- GRAHAM THOMAS 1983** \$13  
One of the most popular English Roses with large rich pure yellow cupped blooms with delicious Tea Rose fragrance. The shrub is very strong-growing very healthy and almost continuous-flowering. Can make an admirable climber to 2m. or a little more.
- HERITAGE 1984** \$16  
Medium-sized cupped blooms with very soft clear pink centres and almost white outer edges. Wonderfully fragrant and healthy and strong growing to about 1.8m. Suitable for use as a pillar rose. PBR
- HERO 1982** \$14  
Sprays of clear pink cupped blooms with the outer petals reflexing. The shrub is rather open and lax in growth and should be placed behind shorter roses. Fragrant.
- JAYNE AUSTIN** \$14  
Beautiful rosettes of soft apricot-yellow often with a button eye. Strong Tea fragrance. medium bushy growth with lots of foliage. To about 1.5m.
- JEAN GALBRAITH 2000** \$14  
A sport of "Abraham Darby". The flowers are quite distinct; the cupped blooms of approx. 40 petals are a very attractive deep buff-apricot colour paling to soft buff as they age. They have a rich fruity fragrance. To about 1.5m.
- JOHN CLARE 1999** \$14  
An extremely prolific rose with medium-sized informally cupped bright pink to light crimson blooms all season. Very pretty. Grows to about 1m. PBR
- JUBILEE CELEBRATION 2004** \$14  
This is one of the finest David Austin roses with large domed blooms of lovely rich salmon-pink with golden tints on the undersides of the petals. Each bloom is elegantly held above the foliage and there is great profusion of flowering. 1.5m.
- JUDE THE OBSCURE 1999** \$14  
Very large cup-shaped flowers. The petals are rich yellow towards the centre while the outer petals are soft yellow. In some weathers this colour seems to be overlaid with pink. The fragrance is outstanding. Medium bushy growth to about 1.2m. PBR.
- JUDE THE OBSCURE** \$32  
Very large cup-shaped flowers. The petals are rich yellow towards the centre while the outer petals are soft yellow. In some weathers this colour seems to be overlaid with pink. The fragrance is outstanding. Medium bushy growth to about 1.2m. PBR Budded only.
- KATHRYN MORLEY 1995** \$14  
An upright growing shrub with large cupped blooms of lovely soft pink with beautiful shape and refinement. Light Tea fragrance. Very lovely. To about 1.2m. or a little taller.
- LADY OF MEGGINCH 2009** \$16  
The blooms start off as pretty, rounded buds that open into large richly coloured rosette shaped flowers. It has a good fruity fragrance and is a very healthy variety. 1.2m.
- LD BRAITHWAITE 1988** \$14  
A bushy shrub with slightly cupped fragrant brilliant crimson blooms all season. Grows to about 1.2m. PBR
- LEANDER 1982** \$14  
Small double apricot blooms in large clusters. Tall robust growth with disease resistant foliage. Fruity fragrance. 1.8m
- LILAC ROSE 1990** \$14  
Clusters of very large every double blooms of lilac-pink opening to flat neatly formed rosettes. Very fragrant. Short bushy growth to less than a metre.
- LILIAN AUSTIN 1973** \$14  
A low arching mounding shrub with semi-double blooms of bright salmon-pink and orange tonings with wavy petal edges. Fragrant. Fairly prickly and arching low growth to about 75cm.
- LITCHFIELD ANGEL 2009** \$16  
Cream to apricot cupped rosettes open to large, more domed, lightly fragrant flowers of a creamy white that gives an overall appearance of a white flush. This rounded bush is ideal for creating a border. 1.2m
- LUCETTA 1983** \$14  
Large semi-double flowers of soft peach fading to almost white with golden stamens. The growth is strong and arching. 2m.
- MARY MAGDALENE 2001** \$14  
Soft apricot-pink colouring with delicate silky petals arranged around a button eye. Dwarf spreading growth with mat green foliage. Lovely tea rose scent.
- MARY ROSE 1983** \$14  
One of the most popular roses with strong bushy growth and a constant display of beautiful double loosely formed fragrant blooms. Grows to about 1.5m. A lovely rose.

<b>MAYOR OF CASTERBRIDGE</b> 1996	<b>\$14</b>
Shallowly cupped bloom of soft pink with a light reverse. Fruity fragrance. Very vigorous upright growth. Well suited to pillars. Recurrent.	
<b>MISS ALICE</b> 2002	<b>\$16</b>
A dwarf bushy shrub with very double soft pink fragrant blooms. An excellent rose for smaller gardens. To about 80cm. PBR.	
<b>MOLINEUX</b> 1999	<b>\$14</b>
A small upright bushy shrub with rich yellow double blooms with touches of light orange on the edges of the central petals. Grows to about 80cm. Fragrant. PBR	
<b>NOBLE ANTONY</b>	<b>\$16</b>
Large double blooms of deep magenta that have outer petals turning back to form a lovely shape. Small plant with mid green foliage. 1m.	
<b>OTHELLO</b> 1968	<b>\$14</b>
A strong-growing rose with very double rich crimson blooms and wonderful fragrance. The blooms are cupped and quartered and the foliage is dark green. Grows to about 1.5m. Budded only.	
<b>PAT AUSTIN</b> 2000	<b>\$14</b>
A wonderful everblooming shrub/small climber with deeply cupped double blooms with bright coppery orange petals and pale yellow reverses to the petals. Dark glossy foliage and strong fragrance. Use as a shrub to about 1.5m. or as a small climber to 2m.	
<b>PEGASUS</b> 2000	<b>\$14</b>
An arching shrub with clusters of fragrant rich apricot-yellow double blooms. Nice shiny foliage. Grows to about 1.2m. tall and wide. PBR. Budded only.	
<b>PERDITA</b> 0	<b>\$16</b>
Perfect quartered blooms of delicate apricot blush on a vigorous medium bushy shrub. Frafrant, recurrent. OF	
<b>PORTMEIRION</b> 2002	<b>\$14</b>
This lovely rose has medium-sized shallowly-cupped blooms of rich clear pink. The fragrance is strong and the shrub is widely spreading but not very tall. To about 1m.	
<b>POTTER AND MOORE</b> 1988	<b>\$14</b>
A seedling from Wife of Bath. Large rose pink blooms that are fully double. They are moderately scented. The plant is short, but quite thick with foliage that is mid green. 90cm.	
<b>PRETTY JESSICA</b> 1983	<b>\$14</b>
Pretty little cupped blooms of rich pink with slightly lilac hints. Fragrant. Short bushy growth to about 80cm.	
<b>RADIO TIMES</b> 1994	<b>\$14</b>
Perfect slightly dome-shaped blooms of pure rich pink with strong fragrance. Small arching growth to about 1.2m. PBR.	
<b>REDOUTE</b> 1992	<b>\$14</b>
A sport of "Mary Rose" with the same characteristics as the parent except for the colour which is soft pink. Quite lovely. To about 1.5m. PBR	
<b>SCEPTER'D ISLE</b> 1996	<b>\$14</b>
A continuous-flowering shrub with clusters of soft pink cupped double blooms showing yellow stamens. Strong fragrance nice leafy growth to about 1.2m. PBR	
<b>SHARIFA ASMA</b> 1989	<b>\$14</b>
A beautiful rose with shallow-cupped blooms of soft pink fading to almost white. The incurving petals reflex at the top to form a perfect rosette. Fragrant. Short upright growth to about 1.2m. PBR	
<b>SHROPSHIRE LASS</b> 1968	<b>\$14</b>
A vigorous spring flowering shrub bearing large delicate flesh-pink single blooms fading to white. 2m.	
<b>SIR EDWARD ELGAR</b> 1992	<b>\$14</b>
This lovely rose has flowers of cupped shape which later recurve to form a neat dome. The colour is a beautiful mix of cerise and crimson-lively without being garish. Growth is upright and vigorous with large dark foliage. To about 1.2m. PBR	
<b>SIR WALTER RALEIGH</b> 1985	<b>\$14</b>
Very fragrant large blooms of rich creamy-pink on dark green semi glossy-glossy foliage. A vigorous plant that blooms throughout the year. 1.25m.	
<b>SOPHY'S ROSE</b> 2001	<b>\$14</b>
A wonderful shrub with a continuous display of very double rosettes of bright crimson-pink. Such a nice little rose with wonderful colour. To about 1m. PBR.	
<b>ST. CECILIA</b> 1987	<b>\$14</b>
A healthy upright shrub producing chalice-shaped double blooms of creamy-pink with strong myrrh-fragrance. Very easy to grow. To about 1.5m. PBR	
<b>ST. SWITHUN</b> 1987	<b>\$14</b>
Very large open cupped blooms filled with frilly petals in a lovely soft pink colour fading to almost white at the edges. A small climber to about 1.8m. PBR	

- STRAWBERRY HILL 2009** \$16  
This extremely healthy variety bears medium sized, pure rose pink, cupped rosettes of superb quality that gradually pale to a lighter shade at the edges. A fine myrrh fragrance with a hint of lemon. 1.2m.
- SUMMER SONG 2007** \$15  
A beautiful and unusual coloured rose best described as burnt orange. The flower is cup shaped when open with a lovely scent. The plant is a bushy upright shrub that can be pruned to grow taller or shorter. P.B.R.
- SWAN 1987** \$14  
Large, white, fragrant blooms with a tinge of lemon in the early stages. A tall strong shrub. 1.5m
- SWEET JULIET 1989** \$14  
Very similar to Jayne Austin. It has flat pretty rosettes of apricot buff and pink. Very leafy plant best for hot climates. 1.2m.
- TAMORA 1983** \$14  
A sweet rose with cupped apricot blooms and strong fragrance. Very tough and reliable. To about 90cm
- TEA CLIPPER 2008** \$16  
An almost completely thornless and large bushy shrub, bearing informal rosette shaped flowers each with a button eye, in a colour of apricot similar to Grace. The fragrance is a mix of tea, myrrh and citrus. 1.4m.
- TEASING GEORGIA 2001** \$14  
A yellow rose of great beauty. The flowers are of a particularly pleasing cupped form. The centre petals are in the form of a rich deep yellow cup while the outer petals fall back and fade to palest yellow providing a very pleasant two-toned effect. 1.5m
- TESS OF THE D'URBERVILLES 2001** \$14  
Large fragrant flowers of bright crimson. They are of a nice deeply cupped shape in the early stages the petals turning back to give a less formal but still attractive flower. They bend over with their weight to give an elegant effect. 1.75m
- THE DARK LADY 1991** \$14  
A dark crimson rose with large loosely -formed double blooms that open wide some what like the flowers of a tree paeony. Spreading medium height to about 1.2m. Strong Old Rose fragrance. PBR budded only.
- THE ENDEAVOUR 2006** \$14  
A variety that particularly favours a warm climate. It has spicy-fragrant salmon-pink blooms with a background of yellow which contrast well with the dark foliage. To 1.2m. New for 2006. PBR budded only.
- THE MAYFLOWER 2003** \$16  
A smaller shrub with "Old Rose" flowers of deep rose pink. It has excellent resistance to black spot and powdery mildew. Twiggy growth to 1.2m.
- THE MILLER 1970** \$14  
Fine mid pink flowers fading towards the edges. Tough and hardy plant with pale green leaves and prickles. 2.5m
- THE PILGRIM 1995** \$14  
An upright shrub carrying beautiful silky flowers of soft yellow. Fragrant and recurrent. 1.7m
- THE PRINCE 1994** \$16  
A low bushy shrub with medium-sized deep purple-red fragrant blooms all season. Grows to about 80cm. PBR
- THE REEVE 1979** \$13  
An especially nice rose with large globular dusky-pink blooms on arching stems. The fragrant flowers are lovely when growing near true Old Fashioned roses and the shrub is tall and arching.
- THE SQUIRE 1976** \$14  
This rose has rosette shaped flowers with many quilled petals of dark crimson. A vigorous medium sized plant with many prickles. Very recurrent. 1m.
- TRADESCANT 1993** \$14  
An attractive arching bush with medium-sized blooms of superb rich wine-crimson. A beautiful rose with rich fragrance. To 1.2m. PBR.
- TROILUS** \$14  
Honey-buff shade with a sweet fragrance. Strong upright growth. Good for hot climates. 1.25m.
- WENLOCK 1984** \$14  
Medium blooms on a shrub growing to 1.5m. A sweet fragrance. Crimson-red. Can be small climber. Good for dry climates.
- WIFE OF BATH 1969** \$14

- WINCHESTER CATHEDRAL 1988** \$14  
A sport of "Mary Rose" with all the same characteristics of the parent except for the colour which is white. A wonderful rose to about 1.5m.
- WINDEMERE 2007** \$15  
A neat and compact plant featuring perfectly rounded buds of rich cream opening to full cupped flowers of almost pure white. The flowers have a delicious fruity fragrance with a definite hint of citrus. P.B.R.
- WINDRUSH** \$14  
Pale lemon yellow flowers on a spreading plant. Flowers are borne in clusters with round hips following if not dead-headed. Quick to repeat. Strong fragrance.
- WISE PORTIA 1982** \$14  
This is a shorter growing shrub with clusters of fully double rosettes of rich crimson-pink all season. They are sweetly fragrant and the shrub is healthy and sturdy to about 1.2m. Budded only.
- YELLOW CHARLES AUSTIN** \$14  
Yellow sport of Charles Austin.

- AGLAIA CUTTING** \$9

A tall upright shrub with clusters of very double clear pink fragrant blooms and glossy foliage. A bit narrow to make a nicely-shaped shrub. Continuous flowering. To about 1.5m. high and 75cm. wide..
- RAINBOW ROBE** 1991 \$11  
Large high-centred blooms of mauve-purple which turn to red as they mature. They are very fragrant and nice for cutting. Grows to about 1m. and is recurrent.
- RECONCILIATION** 1995 \$15  
Nicely fragrant double blooms of peach blended with buff highlights. This is a healthy shrub with few thorns and glossy foliage. Flowers all season and grows to 1.2m.
- RED CEDAR** 1981 \$11  
Also known as "Loving Memory" this rose has well-formed buds which open to bright red double blooms which are good for picking. A very hardy tall rose which flowers throughout the season. To about 1.5m.

- RED CROSS** \$15  
Blossoms are a rich velvet red and produced freely on a healthy bush capable of reaching 1.5m height. The ruffled double blossoms are borne singly and occasionally several to a stem. Strong fragrance.
- RED DEVIL 1970** \$11  
Deep-red beautifully-shaped blossoms which are fragrant and nice for cutting. The foliage is dark and glossy and the shrub will grow to 1.2m. Recurrent flowering.
- RED FAN 1991** \$11  
A healthy shrub with large double unfading orange-red blossoms which are nice for cutting. Recurrent and grows strongly in a tall spreading shape to about 1.2m.
- RED VELVET** \$12  
Large high centred bright velvet red blossoms on very long stems. Tall upright glossy foliage.
- REMEMBER ME 1984** \$15  
A delightful collection of colour including shadings of burnt orange that turns to amber beige and brown. A good producer of basal shoots helps make this a dense plant suitable for hedging. 1.3m P.B.R.
- ROYAL DANE 1971** \$11  
Well-formed deep coppery-orange blossoms maturing to red are fragrant and good for cutting. The blossoms are produced all season and the shrub will grow to 1.5m. The foliage is glossy and healthy. Modern budded only.
- ROYAL HIGHNESS 1962** \$11  
A pretty rose with very fragrant pale pink well-formed blossoms which are suitable for picking. Tall growth to 1.5m. Recurrent flowering.
- SACRED HEART 2003** \$15  
Classic white gold blossoms of utmost purity unfold to perfection on this outstanding rose. A robust performer with glossy deep bronze-green foliage and a lovely fragrance of sweet and spicy citrus. P.B.R.
- SAVOY HOTEL 1989** \$16  
A very pleasant rose with large double well-formed blossoms of light pink with deeper reverses. It is a stocky grower to about 1m and is a useful rose for bedding. Plentiful foliage. Continuous flowering. Modern PBR budded only.
- SIGHTSAVER 2004** \$16  
Full petalled large blossoms of a delicate pink. The highly fragrant flowers are produced in a profusion on a medium growing plant with dense disease free foliage. P.B.R.
- SILVER JUBILEE** \$12  
Pink, apricot, peach and cream flowers that deepen during warmer months. The freely produced blossoms are beautifully formed and the compact bush is highly disease resistant. 1.3m
- SILVER LINING 1958** \$11  
Pale rose pink with a silver base. One of the best and most reliable exhibition roses. 1.4m
- SIR DONALD BRADMAN 2002** \$15  
A magnificently perfumed classic rich red hybrid tea. The plant grows to about 1.5m and is amassed in lush deep green foliage. P.B.R.
- SMOOTH ANGEL** \$16  
A highly fragrant rich cream rose with a glowing yellow apricot centre. The blossom is very full and suitable for picking. Thornless. 1.2m. P.B.R.
- SMOOTH LADY** \$16  
A lovely rose with an appealing glossy foliage. A particularly strong garden variety. The soft salmon pink flowers have an attractive bud. Lovely fragrance. Thornless. 1.7m P.B.R.
- SPICED COFFEE 1990** \$14  
This rose has pale amber flushed lavender-pink buds, which open to lemon scented blossoms of pale beige with lavender edges. Blossoms in flushes throughout the season.
- SPIRIT OF PEACE 1995** \$14  
This is a lovely strong-growing shrub with creamy-apricot high-centred blossoms which are excellent for cutting. Continuous flowering and tallish growth to 1.5m. PBR

- ALBA SEMI-PLENA** *Shade tolerant* \$14  
A tall shrub to 2m. with grey-green foliage and clusters of semi-double creamy white fragrant blooms in Spring and red fruit in Autumn. Possibly the rose used for attar of roses in Bulgaria.
- ALCHYMIST 1956** \$14  
Flowers are deep yellow buff and peach with a strong fragrance. Foliage is glossy mid-green medium vigour growing to 4m. Suitable for pillar or trellis.
- ALFRED DE DELMAS 1855** \$14  
(Moss 1855) A short bushy shrub for the front of the garden with pale pink fragrant blooms all season. They fade in the hot sun and the plant has few prickles.
- AMELIA 1823** \$16  
(Alba) Large pale pink semi-double blooms rather like those of Celsiana. Prominent yellow stamens and nicely fragrant. Not too tall with grey green foliage. Spring flowering. 1.2m
- ANAI SEGALES** \$14  
A pretty rose of rich mauve-crimson with perfectly formed blooms of flat formation and a green eye. Fragrant and flowering only in Spring it will reach about 1.2m. These will sucker.
- ASSEMBLAGEDESBEAUTES.** \$9  
A suckering shrub on its own roots with very double bright crimson fragrant blooms in Spring. The stems are thin and whippy and can be cut to ground level after flowering as the foliage of Gallicas tends to look a bit tired during Summer.
- AUTUMN DELIGHT** \$16  
Pretty clusters of semi-double buff yellow blooms which fade to creamy-white. Fragrant. Recurrent. Medium bush. O.F.
- BARONNE HENRIETTE DE SNOY 1897** \$14  
A sweetly fragrant rose with high pointed creamy flesh-pink blooms which have a deeper pink reverse. Fairly continuous flowering all season. Will grow to about 1.2m. or a little taller. The foliage is large and mid green.
- BARONNE PREVOST 1842** \$16  
(H. perpetual) Large, very double quartered rich pink blooms on a sturdy upright shrub. Fragrant, recurrent.
- BELLE DE CRECY 1828** \$16  
(Gallica 19c) Rich and soft tones of pink purple and violet flowers age to lavender grey. A strong sweet fragrance with smallish dull green leaves on a medium bush. Late spring flowering.
- BELLE POITEVINE** *Shade tolerant* \$14  
A large growing shrub with typical rugosa foliage and quite large loose soft magenta pink blooms showing creamy stamens. They have sweet fragrance and the foliage shows good colouring in Autumn. Sometimes has hips but not as many as the single flowered form
- BELLE POITEVINE - CUTTING** *Shade tolerant* \$9  
A large growing shrub with typical rugosa foliage and quite large loose soft magenta pink blooms showing creamy stamens. They have sweet fragrance and the foliage shows good colouring in Autumn. Sometimes has hips but not as many as the single flowered form
- BERNICE MITCHELL - CUTTING** \$9  
This pretty little rose was found in a garden in the Upper Murray area of Victoria and is a small bushy plant with clusters of pretty lilac pink and mauve fragrant double blooms all season. Can be used as an edging rose or in a pot. Grows to about 50cm.
- BISHOP DARLINGTON 1926** \$14  
This tall shrub has large semi-double blooms of coral-pink opening to creamy-white. Recurrent flowers.
- BLEAK HOUSE 1999** *Shade tolerant* \$14  
This is a seedling of "Schneezwerg" with bright pink fully double blooms in clusters all season. They are fragrant and the foliage is dark and crinkled. Very tough and sets red fruit in Autumn. Will grow to about 1.2m.
- BLEAK HOUSE - CUTTING** *Shade tolerant* \$9  
This is a seedling of "Schneezwerg" with bright pink fully double blooms in clusters all season. They are fragrant and the foliage is dark and crinkled. Very tough and sets red fruit in Autumn. Will grow to about 1.2m. O.F. budded & cuttings.

- BLOOMFIELD ABUNDANCE** \$16  
Also known as Spray Cecil Brunner. A large and vigorous form of Cecil Brunner repeatedly flowering in large clusters in light pink. 3m
- BLOOMFIELD ABUNDANCE - CUTTING** \$9  
Also known as Spray Cecil Brunner. A large and vigorous form of Cecil Brunner repeatedly flowering in large clusters in light pink. 3m
- BLOOMFIELD DAINTY** \$14  
(Hybrid musk 1924) Orange buds that open to canary yellow and fade to pink from the tips, flowers are single with a strong scent of musk. Healthy glossy leaves.
- BLUE BOY 1958** *Shade tolerant* \$14  
A showy rose with long arching almost thornless canes bearing masses of fully double deep reddish-violet blooms in Spring only. Nicely fragrant. Will send out canes to 2m. but they do not stay upright.
- BOULE DE NIEGE 1867** \$14  
Small compact blooms of pure white constant flowering and very hardy.
- BUFF BEAUTY 1939** \$14  
One of the truly lovely shrub roses with everything one could wish for in a rose. The blooms are in large clusters and are soft creamy yellow and have a lovely fragrance. The foliage is dark and healthy. The plant grows strongly into a tall, wide shape.
- CARDINAL DE RICHELIEU 1840** \$14  
One of our favourites with globular buds opening to rich bright crimson-purple double blooms with a button eye. As the blooms age they become grape-purple and slate-grey with silvery-white petal bases. There are few prickles and flexible canes.
- CECILE BRUNNER** \$12  
An old favourite with perfect pale pink buttonhole rosebuds which are repeated all through the season. They are sweetly fragrant and the shrub grows to about 1m. Not to be confused with the taller growing shrub "Bloomfield Abundance" or "Spray Cecile Brunner"
- CECILE BRUNNER - CUTTING** \$9  
An old favourite with perfect pale pink buttonhole rosebuds which are repeated all through the season. They are sweetly fragrant and the shrub grows to about 1m. Not to be confused with the taller growing shrub "Bloomfield Abundance" or "Spray Cecile Brunner"
- CENTIFOLIA VARIEGATA 1845** \$14  
(Centifolia) A tall, arching spring flowering plant with striped white and pale pink flowers.
- CHAPEAU DE NAPOLEAN 1827** \$15  
A famous variation of Centifolia, whereby the buds and sepals of the pink blooms are heavily mossed.
- CHARLES DE MILLS** \$14  
A very lusty tall-growing Gallica with arching growth and a huge Spring display of ruby-crimson blooms. They are very double and flat and have some fragrance. The weight of the flowers weighs the canes down and after flowering the canes should be cut back.
- CHINENSIS MUTABILIS 1894** \$14  
An extremely popular rose which will reach to at least 2m. high and wide. The single blooms open apricot-yellow then turn pink and finally end deep raspberry. The three colours are on the shrub all at the same time and create a pretty effect.
- CHLORIS - CUTTING** \$9  
An almost thornless shrub with arching growth to 2m. at least. The fragrant blooms are soft-pink with reflexed petals in a quartered form and a button eye. The shrub is happy in the shade and very thrifty. Blooms come in Spring only. Cuttings only which may s
- COMMANDANT BEAUREPAIRE 1874** *Shade tolerant* \$14  
This is a healthy shrub with bright green lush foliage and pretty blooms of rose pink streaked with crimson and purple and marbled with white. They are strongly fragrant and appear mainly in Spring, although there are often a few flowers in Autumn.
- COMPLICATA** *Shade tolerant* \$14  
This is a rose of unknown origins but is a beautiful rose to have in any garden. It is a tall arching plant with few prickles and in Spring is absolutely smothered with glowing clear pink single blooms with yellow stamens.
- COMTE DE CHAMBORD** \$16  
A lovely rose with very double warm-pink fragrant blooms and plentiful fresh green foliage. Bushy upright growth to about 1m. so is best in the forefront of the garden. Dislikes wet weather which can spoil the flowers. Recurrent flowering. O.F. budded only.
- COMTESSE VANDAL 1932** \$14  
Beautiful buds open to large double salmon-pink blooms with orange-pink reverse and strong fragrance. Recurrent. 1.4m

- CORNELIA 1925** \$14  
This is an arching shrub but is also effective as a pillar rose if clipped in short. It has clusters of small salmon-pink blooms with strong fragrance and dark green foliage. A lovely continuous flowering rose which will grow to about 2.5m.
- DELAMBRE** \$14  
This is a pretty little rose with clusters of small double reddish-pink fragrant blooms in great profusion in Spring with some more flowers in Autumn in good years. To about 80cm.
- DELAMBRE - CUTTING** \$9  
This is a pretty little rose with clusters of small double reddish-pink fragrant blooms in great profusion in Spring with some more flowers in Autumn in good years. To about 80cm.
- DELICATA 1898** *Shade tolerant* \$14  
A pretty rose with typical Rugosa foliage and clusters of soft lilac-pink semi-double fragrant blooms all season. Grows to about 1m. and has large orange-red fruit in Autumn.
- DEVONIENSIS** \$14  
Large double flat cream blooms with a pinkish apricot centre. Fragrant, recurrent. Shortish spreading growth.
- DUCHESS DE BRABANT** \$14  
A beautiful rose with small clusters of pearl-pink double cupped blooms. They are sweetly fragrant and are borne repeatedly all season. Foliage is light green and the shrub grows to about 1m. with few thorns. O.F. budded & cuttings.
- DUCHESS DE MONTEBELLO** \$14  
(Gallica) A very beautiful rose with sprays of blush-pink double blooms of open cupped formation. They are sweetly fragrant and come in such numbers that the flexible canes are weighed down. Foliage is light green and healthy. Will grow to about 1.2m.
- DUCHESS DE PORTLAND 1800** *Shade tolerant* \$14  
Very neat bush bears lush green foliage and single deep crimson/pink blooms with yellow stamens. Recurrent.
- DUPONTII 1817** *Shade tolerant* \$14  
A very beautiful shrub rose with clusters of single milky-white blooms in Spring. Foliage is plentiful and grey-green and the plant will grow to about 2.5m. The flowers are fragrant and there are orange fruit in Autumn. One of our great favourites.
- ELLEN WILLMOTT 1936** \$16  
Beautiful single cream and pink blooms with wavy petal edges and prominent stamens on a bushy upright shrub. Recurrent.
- ELMSHORN 1951** \$12  
Double cupped blooms of fragrant deep pink. Repeat flowering.
- ETOILE DE HOLLANDE 1919** \$16  
A famous old rose with double dark red blooms with wonderful fragrance. The shrub will grow to about 1m. and produces blooms all season.
- EXCELLENZ VON SCHUBERT** \$9  
An easy rose to grow with bushy growth fresh green foliage and arching canes weighed down with large clusters of rosy-pink double blooms all season. The Autumn display can be especially abundant if old blooms are removed. Grows to about 1..2m
- FANTIN LATOUR** \$14  
This famous rose with few thorns has wonderful rounded cupped huge pale pink blooms with deeper pink in the tightly packed central petals. The fragrance is heady and the foliage is handsome. Best pruned to about 1.5m. Can grow to almost climbing proportions.
- FELICIA** *Shade tolerant* \$14  
A favourite with many people "Felicia" has clusters of very fragrant medium-sized soft pink blooms with yellow petal bases. It is not a spectacular rose but is a nicely shaped shrub with pleasing foliage and the ability to produce flowers all season.
- FELLENBERG** \$14  
A cheery crimson-pink rose with double fragrant cupped blooms on strong canes. It is almost tall enough to be a climber. Recurrent flowering and dark green foliage. A nice companion for "Chinensis Mutabilis". It enjoys a hot sunny site in the garden.
- FRANCIS DUBREUIL 1894** \$16  
(Tea) A smallish rose with double black-red very fragrant blooms with no hint of purple as they age. The blooms are not overly large, but are quite lovely. Protection from the late afternoon sun would stop blooms from crisping. 1m
- FRANCIS E LESTER 1946** \$14  
Large clusters of strongly perfumed, medium sized, single white flowers edged with pink. Vigorous growth.
- FRAU KARL DRUSHKI 1901** \$14  
Could be classified as a H. Tea but leans more towards H. Perpetual in my opinion. A very robust shrub with large pink tinted buds which open to large cupped pure white blooms which are good for picking. Not much fragrance but wonderfully recurrent.

- FRITZ NOBIS 1940** *Shade tolerant* **\$14**  
This is a splendid shrub which is smothered in blooms all along arching branches in Spring. The fragrant blooms are double and soft salmon-pink and are pretty in the bud stage. The foliage is grey-green and the shrub will grow to 1.8m. Needs room to spread.
- FRU DAGMAR HASTRUP 1914** *Shade tolerant* **\$14**  
A beautiful shrub rose with typical healthy foliage of Rugosa roses and large single clear soft pink blooms all season. They are sweetly fragrant and in Autumn there is a huge crop of big red fruit which the birds love.
- FRU DAGMAR HASTRUP - CUTTING** *Shade tolerant* **\$9**  
A beautiful shrub rose with typical healthy foliage of Rugosa roses and large single clear soft pink blooms all season. They are sweetly fragrant and in Autumn there is a huge crop of big red fruit which the birds love.
- FRUHLINGGOLD** *Shade tolerant* **\$14**  
This is one of our favourite roses which is smothered with beautiful semi-double pale yellow fragrant blooms showing buff stamens. The shrub is almost tree-like and the blooms are carried all along the branches in Spring. It is nicest if not pruned much.
- FRUHLINGSMORGEN** *Shade tolerant* **\$14**  
Another beautiful rose in this group. It is a shorter shrub than "Fruhlingsgold" and has beautiful single pink blooms with soft yellow centres and prominent maroon stamens. They are sweetly fragrant and appear mainly in Spring. The shrub is widely spreading
- GENERAL GALLIENI 1899** **\$16**  
A strong-growing shrub with fragrant ruffled informal blooms of maroon-red and coppery-red with buff centres. This is a favourite of ours but is not for the lover of perfect buds and bloom. The bush is very vigorous and will grow to at least 1.5m. high
- GENERAL KLEBER 1856** **\$15**  
(Moss Rose 1856) Beautiful flowers of bright, shiny pink that are fully double in a quartered rosette form. They have a strong and sweet fragrance. Stems are smooth and leaves healthy and lush. Spring flowering. 1.7m.
- GENERAL SCHABLIKIKE 1878** **\$15**  
An abundant rose with a continuous display of rich coppery-pink double flat fragrant blooms all season. The foliage is dark green and leathery. It grows very sturdily to about 1.2m. and is a nicely shaped plant which requires minimum pruning.
- GLOIRE DE GUILAN** **\$16**  
(Damask) This is a most undemanding rose with masses of pretty, fragrant semi-double clear rose-pink blooms all along the arching canes in Spring. Fragrance is excellent and the shrub is vigorous to about 2m.
- GLOIRE DE GUILAN** **\$9**  
(Damask) This is a most undemanding rose with masses of pretty, fragrant semi-double clear rose-pink blooms all along the arching canes in Spring. Fragrance is excellent and the shrub is vigorous to about 2m.
- GLOIRE LYONNAISE 1885** **\$14**  
(H. Perpetual) A strong-growing shrub with almost thornless canes and double creamy-white fragrant blooms. Tends to be very tall and should be pruned quite hard. The foliage is dark green and matt. Recurrent flowering. To about 1.8m.
- GOLDEN WINGS 1956** **\$16**  
Beautiful single soft lemon blooms with dark stamens and light green foliage. The blooms are usually in small clusters and are carried recurrently all season. Growth can be to about 1.5m.
- GROOTENDORST SUPREME 1936** **\$15**  
(H. Rugosa 1936) This rose has been called F.J. Grootendorst in the past. It has small dark red carnation-like blooms all season on a bushy shrub.
- GRUSS AN AACHEN 1909** **\$14**  
What a wonderful little shrub this is!! It has clusters of very double creamy-apricot pink fragrant blooms which are mainly cream in Summer. The foliage is dark green and pleasant and the shrub is always nicely shaped and bushy. Grows to about 1m.
- HEBES LIP** **\$14**  
(Damask) Cupped semi double creamy white blooms with crimson edges. Very thorny spreading growth. Spring flowering.
- HENRY HUDSON** **\$16**  
Healthy and hardy shrub with pink buds that open to pure white in hot weather. Flowers are open and semi-double displaying yellow stamens. Pale green leaves on very prickly stems. Dense growth. Can sucker to 1m.
- HERMOSA 1840** **\$14**  
Double cupped small lilac pink blooms and grey green foliage make this a pretty rose. Recurrent. Short, bushy.

- HIPPOLYTE** \$14  
A vigorous almost thornless rose with clusters of flat little blooms of soft violet with brighter cerise highlights. The blooms are carried along arching canes and make a pretty sight in Spring. Can grow to about 1.5m. and can arch outwards.
- HONEY FLOW** 1957 \$15  
An Australian rose with clusters of fragrant white single blooms with a blush of palest pink on the outer edge. Neat bushy growth, recurrent flowering. Nice light foliage.
- HONORINE DE BRABANT** 1874 \$16  
(Bourbon) A leafy healthy shrub with cupped semi-double fragrant blooms of soft pink with lilac stripes. Recurrent. Tall spreading growth.
- IRISH ELEGANCE** 1905 \$16  
Single soft coppery apricot blooms opening from lovely elegant buds. Recurrent, fragrant. Medium height.
- IRISH FIRE FLAME** 1914 \$14  
Single flowers open dark orange-pink with a yellow centre and golden stamens. Medium sweet scent. Constantly repeats. The plant is healthy and reasonably vigorous with Hybrid Tea type prickles and leaves.
- ISPAHAN** 1832 \$14  
(Damask) An upright plant growing to about 2m., bearing medium, pink flowers with a lovely fragrance. Spring flowering only.
- JACQUES CARTIER** 1868 *Shade tolerant* \$16  
(Portland) A pretty shrub with lots of foliage and neat upright growth habit. The blooms are fully double palest pink of cupped formation with a button-eye. The blooms are sweetly fragrant and repeat throughout the season.
- JAMES MASON** 1982 \$14  
(Gallica) A medium sized upright bush featuring highly fragrant large bright blood red flowers with yellow stamens. Not repeat flowering.
- JAMES MITCHELL** \$9  
A very tall and vigorous with small lilac-pink double blooms with a button-eye. The buds are nicely mossed and the blooms are fragrant. Spring flowering only. To about 2m. Cuttings only.
- JAMES VEITCH** 1863 \$16  
(Moss) A short spreading shrub with slatey purple double blooms all season. Fragrant. Very appealing.
- JEAN DUCHER** 1889 \$16  
(Tea) This is a marvellous rose with few thorns and large full globular blooms of soft salmon-pink blooms all season. Very easy to grow and fragrant as well. Usually grows to 1.2m.
- JENS MUNK** \$16  
Very hardy plant with lightly cupped semi-double rich pink flowers with pale stamens. Flowers in small clusters repeatedly and will have hips in autumn. 1.25m.
- JENS MUNK - CUTTING** \$9  
Very hardy plant with lightly cupped semi-double rich pink flowers with pale stamens. Flowers in small clusters repeatedly and will have hips in autumn. 1.25m.
- JERSEY BEAUTY** 1899 \$16  
Flowers are short lived, pale buff yellow with dark yellow stamens. Blooms come in clusters followed by bright red hips. Healthy, glossy, dark foliage. Occasionally repeating.
- JOAN ANDERSON** 1924 \$16  
(Else Poulson) A vigorous bushy plant that has bright pink wavy petals with white patches at the centre that open to reveal stamens. It is a repeat flowerer and slightly fragrant. 1m.
- JOHN HOPPER** \$14  
An upright rose with large fragrant rose-pink double quartered blooms with lilac edges. A bit prone to mildew and blackspot in our climate. Recurrent flowering. To 1.2m. which is more compact than the usual H. Perpetual. O.F. budded only.
- JUNO - CUTTING** *Shade tolerant* \$9  
This is one of our favourite roses with beautiful blush-pink globular flat blooms with a large button eye. They are wonderfully fragrant and the shrub is a lax grower to about 1.2m. and arching. Although it only blooms in Spring it is a lovely rose. Cuttings
- KATHLEEN HARROP** 1919 \$14  
(Bourbon) A sport of "Zephirine Drouhin" with pale pink informal blooms and no thorns. Very fragrant and suitable for arches and pergolas or can be kept as a large shrub. A lovely rose which looks pretty when planted with Zephirine Drouhin. Recurrent. 3m
- KAZANLIK** \$14  
(Damask) Also known as "Trigintipetala" this rose is grown extensively in Bulgaria for rose oil. It is a rather tall prickly somewhat unattractive shrub with loosely double clear pink blooms in Spring. Sweetly fragrant.

- KEW RAMBLER 1913** *Shade tolerant* **\$9**  
A very vigorous thorny Rambler with large clusters of single soft pink blooms with a paler centre and golden stamens. Beautiful grey-green foliage. A wonderful sight when in full bloom in Spring. Fragrant. Grows to about 5m. Cuttings.
- KEW RAMBLER 1913** **\$14**  
A very vigorous thorny Rambler with large clusters of single soft pink blooms with a paler centre and golden stamens. Beautiful grey-green foliage. A wonderful sight when in full bloom in Spring. Fragrant. Grows to about 5m.
- LA BELLE SULTAN 1810** **\$16**  
Tall shrub with almost no prickles and arched canes. Flowers are almost single, opening crimson but quickly changing to deep violet with white petal bases around a large cluster of yellow stamens.
- LA REINE 1842** **\$15**  
(H. Perpetual) High scented buds opening to large globular blooms of silvery rose pink and a hint of lilac. Highly fragrant and continuous flowering.
- LA VILLE DE BRUXELLES 1849** **\$14**  
(Damask) Large double pink blooms with quartered petal formation and rich fragrance on a tall arching prickly shrub with nice foliage. Spring flowering. OF.
- LADY HILLINGDON** **\$14**  
A delightful old rose which has remained a favourite since its introduction. It has long pointed buds which open to large cupped tulip-shaped rich apricot-yellow to cream blooms which nod attractively. The fragrance is of dried apricots and is quite lovely.
- LADY MANN 1937** **\$14**  
This was bred from "Lorraine Lee" and at first glance it looks similar but the growth is much more robust the foliage is darker and there is less orange in the mid-pink blooms. Very strong growth to 1.8m. and very recurrent.
- LADY MARY FITZWILLIAM 1882** **\$15**  
Beautiful soft pink double blooms with deeper shadings on a medium to short shrub. Fragrant. Recurrent.
- LAURA LOUISA 1995** **\$15**  
Fragrant double flowers of medium pink to salmon. A sport of Leverkusen mainly spring flowering. Grows better with support. P.B.R.
- LAVENDER LASSIE 1960** **\$16**  
(Hybrid musk) 1960. Medium sized, double flowers of lilac pink, produced in large clusters which are very fragrant. Vigorous tall growth.
- LEDA 1827** **\$15**  
(Damask 1827) The painted Damask has very fragrant double flowers of pure white to a few traces of crimson on the tips of the outermost petals. Can be recurrent if pruned after flowering. It is a hardy plant with dark green foliage. 1.25m.
- LORD PENZANCE 1894** **\$14**  
Flowers of soft rosy yellow paler at base and yellow stamens. Fragrant single blooms in clusters with small dark foliage and is a very vigorous rose. Summer blooming.
- LOUISE ODIER 1851** **\$14**  
(bourbon) A tall upright rose with lovely cupped rose-pink fragrant blooms with hints of lavender. Repeat flowers all season. Nice olive-green foliage. Can grow to about 1.5m.
- MAMON COCHET PINK** **\$14**  
A strong-growing Tea with very double pink blooms. Fragrant and recurrent. To about 1.5m. or a bit taller. O.F.
- MARIE VAN HOUTTE 1871** **\$14**  
This is one of the great Tea roses with beautiful double high-centred creamy blooms with pink and soft yellow tonings. Always seems to be in flower and is healthy and hardy. The foliage is dark and growth is vigorous to more than a metre.
- MARY GUTHRIE 1929** **\$14**  
A dwarf bush with healthy growth producing large clusters of small rich pink fragrant single flowers all season. To about 75cm.
- MME DE TARTAS 1859** **\$13**  
(Tea) Fully double pale pink blowsy blooms appear throughout the season on a rather sprawling shrub. 1.2m
- MME GEORGES BRUANT** **\$14**  
A lovely rugosa hybrid, it has semi-double pure white papery petals with a centre of pale yellow stamens. Attractive bright green foliage. Repeat. 2m
- MME LEGRA ST GERMAINE** **\$13**
- MME. HARDY 1832** **\$14**  
This beautiful rose blooms only in Spring but every garden should have one. It grows strongly to more than 1.5m. and has plenty of prickles and mid-green foliage. The exquisite blooms are often in clusters and open with a slight pink tinge.

- MME.HARDY - CUTTING 1832** \$9  
(Damask)This beautiful rose blooms only inSpringbut every garden shouldhave one.It grows strongly to more than 1.5m. and has plenty of prickles and mid-green foliage.The exquisite blooms are often in clusters and open with a slight pink tinge.
- MME.LOMBARD 1878** \$14  
(Tea)A nice old Tea rose with very double rose-salmon fragrant blooms with deeper coppery centres.The shrub flowers continuously all season.A neat bushy shrub to about 1.2m.
- MME.PLANTIER - CUTTING 1835** \$9  
(Alba)A very vigorous rambling shrub with very few thorns and creamy double blooms with a green pointel.Fragrant and very tough especially tolerant of shade and dryness.Spring flowering.Cuttings only.
- MOLLY SHARMAN CRAWFORD 1908** \$14  
(Tea)This is a very nice shrub with very double high-centred pure white blooms with greenish highlights. They are fragrant and produced all season. The foliage is dark and healthy and the shrub is nice and bushy. 1m. OF
- MONSIEUR TILLIER(A. JOSEPH) 1872** \$14  
(Tea)This is a beautiful rose which is extremely vigorous and can grow very tall and wide.The flowers are cupped and coppery pink sometimes showing buff tonings.It would prefer to be grown in a site away from blistering heat .
- MOONLIGHT 1913 *Shade tolerant*** \$16  
(H.Musk)A large spreading shrub with clusters of small almost single white blooms with prominent yellow stamens.The foliage is dark green and there is a good crop of small red hips in Autumn as well as flowers.The flowers are soft yellow in Autumn.1.8m
- MRS DUDLEY CROSS 1907** \$16  
(Tea)An almost thornless tea rose with fully double soft yellow blooms deepening to pink flushed crimson. Slightly fragrant.
- MRS HERBERT STEVENS 1910** \$14  
Lovely hybrid tea for hot dry climates, blooms are pure white with a tiny yellow blush at the centre. A hint of green on the outer petals.Can spoil quickly in rain.Lovely tea scent. Thrives in poor soil.1.25m.
- MRS OAKLEY FISHER** \$16  
A delightful rose with single apricot blooms and yellow stamens.The foliage is deep bronze and quite healthy. Fairly prickly.The shrub will grow to about 75cm. Recurrent.
- MRS. JOHN LANG 1887** \$14  
(Hybrid perpetual) This bush bares well -shaped, double, silvery-pink fragrant blooms throughout the season. 1.5m
- MRS.ALBERT NASH 1929** \$14  
A moderate sized ever blooming shrub with small double dark red fragrant flowers. Recurrent. To about 1m.
- MRS.RICHARD TURNBULL 1945** \$14  
A very large vigorous climber bearing large single almost white blooms in Spring.Require strong support and is similar to "Mermaid".
- NEVADA 1927** \$14  
Flowering constantly this large almost thornless shrub produces large almost single creamy roses.
- OCTAVIUS WELD** \$14  
Double pale creamy pink with lemon shading. Fragrant, medium bush. Recurrent.
- ORANGE TRIUMPH** \$14  
A vigorous climber producing clusters of small pom poms of orange red blooms.Recurrent.1.5m.
- ORLEANS ROSE** \$13  
This is a hardy little shrub with clusters of small double bright crimson-red blooms with a pale centre.The foliage is glossy and light-green and the bush will grow to about 75cm.It flowers continuously.
- ORLEANS ROSE - CUTTING 1909** \$9  
This is a hardy little shrub with clusters of small double bright crimson-red blooms with a pale centre.The foliage is glossy and light-green and the bush will grow to about 75cm.It flowers continuously.Cuttings only.
- PAUL RICAULT 1845** \$15  
A Centifolia-like rose that has fully double glowing rich pink, fragrant, quartered flowers. A vigorous well foliated shrub. Spring flowering. 1.5m.
- PAX 1918 *Shade tolerant*** \$14  
A large spreading shrub with fragrant loose semi-double creamy-white blooms showing yellow stamens.They are held in clusters.The foliage is darkest green and the shrub will grow to 1.8m.high and almost as wide.It is recurrent.

- PEARL D'OR 1884** \$14  
Yellow Cecile Brunner. A blend of yellow to apricot flowers; not as shapely as Cecile Brunner. Flowers all season on open sprays. It has a good tea fragrance bushy and compact plant with olive green leaves that tinge bronze early.
- PENELOPE 1924** *Shade tolerant* \$15  
A wonderful shrub which never fails to please. Everything about this rose is right-the clusters of semi-double creamy-pink blooms have delicious fragrance and the dark green foliage is attractive.
- PINK GROOTENDORST 1923** \$14  
Sport of F J Grootendorst. Blooms of candy pink to salmon not unlike a carnation. Recurrent. Sturdy easy to grow rose reaching 1.2m.
- PRINCESS DE SAGAN** \$16  
This is a pretty rose which blooms all season. The small to medium-sized flowers are cupped and double and are bright crimson with purple tones which make a cheery splash of colour. Healthy foliage good fragrance and will grow to about 1m.
- PROSPERITY 1914** \$14  
A very good natured rose with huge clusters of medium size double blooms of white with a slight pink blush upon opening. The foliage is dark and glossy and the shrub is a strong grower. Fragrant. 1.5m.
- QUATRE SAISONS 1660** \$15  
(Damask) An ancient rose with loosely-formed soft clear-pink blooms in small clusters. Tall arching prickly growth pretty foliage and strong fragrance make this a lovely rose. Recurrent as well. 1.5m.
- QUEEN OF DENMARK** \$14  
Big clusters of beautiful clear pink very double cupped and quartered blooms with a button eye. The foliage is dark grey-green and the growth is arching to about 1.5m. Quite prickly but a beautiful fragrant member of the Alba family. Spring flowering .
- RAUBRITTER - CUTTING 1936** *Shade tolerant* \$9  
A trailing shrub with clusters of very cupped small dusky-pink blooms rather like small versions of La Reine Victoria. They are very fragrant. The long canes are smothered with blooms in Spring and are really quite breathtaking.
- RAVENSWORTH** \$14  
A yellow form of Perle d'Or with clusters of small straw-yellow blooms in spring. recurrent. OF.
- REINE DES VIOLETTES 1860** *Shade tolerant* \$14  
(H. Perpetual) A wonderful shrub in all respects. The foliage is grey-green and the flat double quartered blooms are soft violet-purple and the shrub is almost thornless. The blooms are fragrant as well. Seems to be in flower all season.
- ROSA FORRESTIANA** \$14  
A Spring-flowering shrub with small clusters of pinkish-crimson single blooms with creamy-buff anthers followed by bottle-shaped hips. This rose originated in South-Western China.
- ROSA GALLICA OFFICINALLIS** \$14  
"The Apothecary's Rose" A very old rose with semi-double bright crimson blooms showing yellow stamens. Fragrant. Spring flowering. Arching growth to 1m. O.F.
- ROSA HUGONIS 1899** \$14  
"Father Hugo's Rose". A tall upright branching shrub with single primrose-yellow blooms all along the stems in Spring. These are followed by small purple hips in Autumn. A nice specimen rose to about 2m. Probably originated in China.
- ROSA INERMIS MORLETTI 1883** \$14  
A vigorous thornless shrub bearing small semi-double deep magenta-pink blooms. Mainly spring flowering.
- ROSA LAEVIGATA 1759** \$16  
Originally from China this beautiful rose has glossy green foliage and large single white fragrant blooms with yellow stamens. Can climb to about 5m. Or can be allowed to grow without support as an arching rambler. Spring flowering.
- ROSA LONGICUSPIS** \$9  
A very vigorous climber with glossy green foliage and lovely airy clusters of small single white flowers with pretty stamens. They are sweetly fragrant and are followed by a big crop of red hips in Autumn. This rose needs plenty of room to grow.
- ROSA MICRUGOSA ALBA** \$14  
This is a hardy shrub which will grow to about 1.2m. and has a continuous display of single papery-white blooms all season. It is a cross between R. roxburghii and R. rugosa and the foliage is olive-green.
- ROSA MULTIFLORA CARNEA 1804** \$9  
A very vigorous climber with clusters of small very double blush pink fragrant blooms in Spring. Will flower in total shade and dry sites. Foliage is grey-green. Lovely for climbing into trees.

- ROSA OMEIENSIS PTERCANTHA** \$14  
"Maltese Cross Rose". An unusual and spectacular shrub with single white blooms all along the branches in spring with small round red hips in Autumn. The stems of this rose have huge flattened red thorns and the foliage is fernlike.
- ROSA PENDULINA** 1683 \$14  
"Alpine Rose". One of the more handsome European wild roses with few thorns. The flowers are light purple-red and the stems are also purple when young and they are arching. has nice hips. Spring flowering.
- ROSA POMIFERA DUPLEX** \$14  
A spring flowering shrub rose, with stout arching branches and small, semi-double, clear pink flowers with an apple like fragrance, followed by large crimson hips.
- ROSA RUBRIFOLIA** \$14  
A tall shrub with blue-plum stems with few thorns. The small single blooms are soft lilac-pink and easily overlooked. It is used mainly as a feature plant for the beautiful colour of the foliage and the stems.
- ROSA SWEGINZOWII MACROCARPA** \$14  
A large angular shrub with single bright pink blooms in Spring followed by large shiny red flagon-shaped hips in Autumn. Beautiful fernlike foliage. Needs space to spread and show off its lovely shape. To about 2.5m. high and wide. A native of N.W. China.
- ROSA VIRGINIANA** \$9  
One of the nicest shrubs with rich fresh green foliage and bright pink single blooms in Spring. Masses of bright red round hips in Autumn with colourful foliage. Tall bushy growth. Cuttings will sucker.
- ROSA WATSONIANA** 0 \$9  
"The Bamboo Rose". An unusual shrub with long narrow pale green foliage with white patches which resemble the foliage of a Japanese Maple. Blooms are small and insignificant. The shrub is short and almost weeping in shape.
- ROSA XANTHINA** 1906 \$14  
Flowers are soft yellow borne on short-stalks. Spring flowering. Tall growth. Not as beautiful as "Canary Bird". The buds of these plants came from the Royal Botanic Gardens in Melbourne.
- ROSE MARIE VIAD** \$14  
Seedling of Veilchenblau. Thornless climbing rose with lovely clusters of crimson purple fading to violet. Flecks of white are also in the petals. 4m
- ROSERAI DE L'HAY.OF** *Shade tolerant* \$16  
This is one of the loveliest roses ever bred. The blooms are loosely double in clusters and the colour is intense crimson-purple with creamy stamens. The fragrance is a superb mix of cloves and honey and it flowers almost continuously all season.
- ROSERIE D LA HAY CUTTING** \$9  
This is one of the loveliest roses ever bred. The blooms are loosely double in clusters and the colour is intense crimson-purple with creamy stamens. The fragrance is a superb mix of cloves and honey and it flowers almost continuously all season.
- ROSETTE DELIZY** 1922 \$16  
This rose produces large blooms that are colourful mix of yellow apricot red to carmine tones. The bush is able to grow to 2 metres and has glossy mid-green leaves. It flowers continuously and has a strong tea scent.
- RUBENS** 1859 \$16  
(Tea) Flowers are creamy pink and long and delicate in shape. Very healthy foliage with red prickles and a spreading habit of growth.
- RUGOSA RUGSPIN** \$14  
Introduced from Denmark. This is a beautiful plant with clusters of single deep wine-purple with yellow stamens. Wonderful foliage of true rugosa-type which colours nicely in Autumn.
- RUGOSA SCABROSA** 1960 *Shade tolerant* \$14  
Another excellent rose in this popular family with clusters of single almost cerise fragrant blooms with yellow stamens. The foliage is typically healthy of true Rugosa type and it colours well in Autumn.
- RUGOSA TYPICA** *Shade tolerant* \$9  
A nice shrub with excellent foliage and single soft lilac-pink fragrant blooms all season. This variety sets a lot of red hips which should be cut off until Autumn as the flowering will be reduced if allowed to stay on the shrub. Can grow to about 2m.
- RUSSELLIANA** 1840 \$14  
Clusters of small fully double crimson red blooms on a thorny vigorous rambler. Fragrant. Spring flowering.

- SAFRANO 1839** **\$16**  
One of the oldest tea roses. Each bloom has fully double opening to flat buff to apricot blooms with a sulphur yellow base. Healthy mid green foliage. 1m.
- SARAH VAN FLEET 1926** *Shade tolerant* **\$14**  
(H. Rugosa) This beautiful rose blooms very early in the season and continues until late Autumn. Lovely warm pink semi-double fragrant blooms in clusters and fresh green foliage make this an appealing rose. Tall growth to at least 2m.
- SCHNEEZWERG 1912** *Shade tolerant* **\$14**  
(Rugosa) A very recurrent shrub with clusters of semi-double white blooms showing yellow stamens. Foliage is dense and plentiful though not typically Rugosa type. There are large numbers of small round red hips all season as well as flowers.
- SCHOENERS NUTKANA 1930** **\$14**  
A vigorous shrub with large single clear rose-pink flowers and grey-green foliage. Quite fragrant. Growth arching but dense with very few thorns on darkish wood.
- SILVER MOON - CUTTING** **\$9**  
(Hybrid laevigata) Very large silvery white blooms that are almost single and lightly cupped. Glossy leathery green foliage on a very vigorous plant. Flowers only once. 6m
- SILVERMOON.G 1910** **\$14**  
(Hybrid laevigata) Very large silvery white blooms that are almost single and lightly cupped. Glossy leathery green foliage on a very vigorous plant. Flowers only once. 6m
- SINGLE CHERRY** **\$16**  
Lovely bright cherry-red single flowers with some light pink blotching. Grey-green foliage on a short, bushy plant. It has black hips later in autumn. 1m.
- SINGLE LILAC** **\$14**  
Lovely light lilac, single flowers. Grey-green foliage on a short, bushy plant. It has black hips later in autumn. 1m.
- SISSINGHURST CASTLE** **\$14**  
A neat low-growing bush with dark green foliage bearing blooms of purple to deep plum with golden stamens. Spring flowering. To about 80cm.
- SOUPERT ET NOTTING 1874** **\$14**  
(Moss) A short-growing shrub with globular deep pink fragrant blooms with sparsely mossed buds. Recurrent flowering. Foliage is grey-green.
- SOUVENIR DE MALMAISON** **\$14**  
Large richly perfumed double blooms of soft creamy blush. The flowers tend to ball in wet conditions but still very much worth growing. Recurrent.
- SOUVENIR DE PHILEMON COCHET** **\$14**  
(H. Rugosa) A sport of Blanc double de Coubert with very double, white, fragrant flowers. Recurrent.
- SOUVENIR DE ST. ANNES 1950** **\$14**  
(Bourbon) Sport of "Souvenir de la Malmaison" with much better resistance to wet weather and better growth altogether. The blooms are creamy-pink and are semi-double showing yellow stamens. The fragrance is delightful. Recurrent flowering and grows to 1.2m
- SOUVENIR DU DOCTEUR JAMAIN 1865** **\$14**  
(Hybrid perpetual) This plant grows to about 2m bearing fragrant, deep port wine flowers. Recurrent.
- STANWELL PERPETUAL** *Shade tolerant* **\$14**  
This is a great favourite with many gardeners. The beautifully fragrant palest-pink blooms are fully double and flat with a button eye. They sit among the grey-green fernlike foliage and are carried repeatedly throughout the season. Stems are very prickly.
- TRIOMPHE DE LUXEMBOURG 1840** **\$14**  
(Tea) Large double salmon and buff blooms with a lovely fragrance. The plant has quite a lot of thorns and is purple in colour. 1.23m
- TUSCANY - CUTTING** **\$9**  
This spring flowering plant bears velvety maroon flowers with contrasting yellow stamens.
- TUSCANY SUPERB** **\$14**  
A lovely semi-double maroon-red bloom with some golden stamens showing when fully open. Strong fragrance and there are few thorns on the wiry upright stems. Foliage is matt-green and flowers only come in Spring. To about 1m.
- VARIEGATA DI BOLOGNA** *Shade tolerant* **\$14**  
Sounds like some kind of European sausage! However this is a crazy striped rose with white double blooms with purple striping. They are held in clusters and are sweetly fragrant. Spring flowering.
- VICTOR EMMANUAL** **\$15**  
Thought to be a parent of Variegata di Bologna, this fully double rose differs only in flower colour, being wine red to purple with some tiny white specks near the petal's edge.

**WHITE MAMAN COCHET 1896 \$14**

A strong-growing Tea with very double creamy blooms with pink outer petals. The overall effect is hardly "white" but it is a nice rose anyway. Fragrant and recurrent. To about 1.5m. or a bit taller. O.F.

**WILLIAM LOBB 1855 Shade tolerant \$14**

(Moss) A tall arching shrub with clusters of loosely double purple fragrant blooms with grey-purple reverses. The dark foliage is serrated and the buds are covered with plentiful green moss. A favourite since Victorian times for buttonholes. Spring flowering

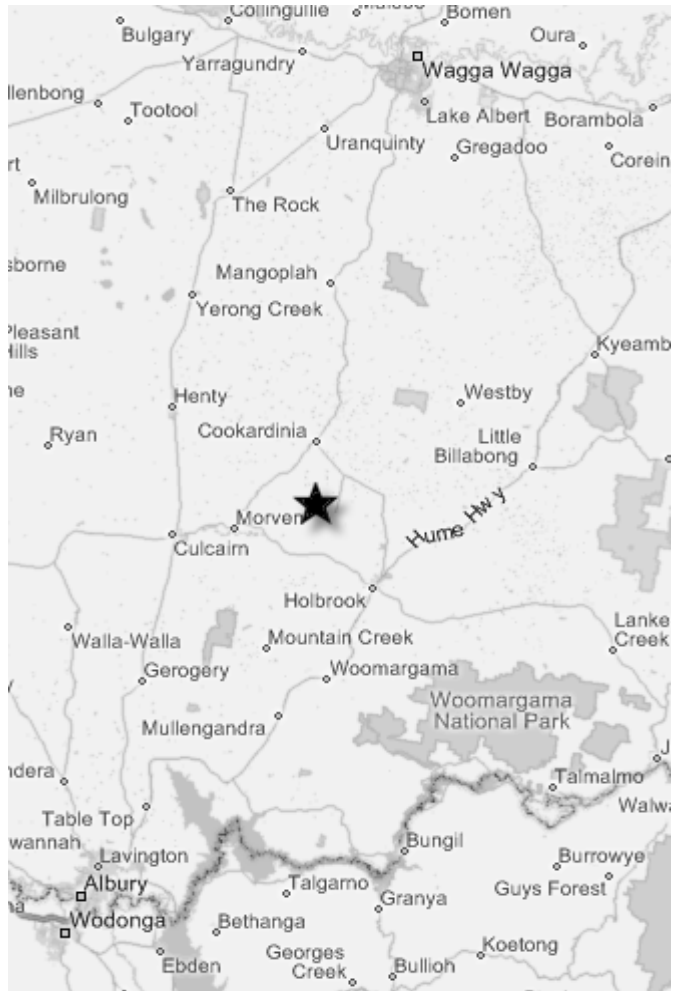
